

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE ECG PATCH SENSOR RETURN STATUS (EDR) FORM

I. General Instructions

The ECG Patch Sensor Return Status Form is completed by ARIC field center staff after the participant returns an ECG Patch sensor to the clinic. This form tracks the date an ECG Patch sensor is returned and the date it is sent to the reading center for processing. Only one occurrence of the ECG Patch form is allowed.

II. Detailed Instructions for Each Item

0a. Enter the date the form was completed.

0b. Enter the staff code of the person who completed this form.

A. Sensor Return Information

- 1. Item 1 is the applied sensor serial number. This serial number is automatically filled from the first occurrence of the EIO form. Before proceeding, ensure that the serial number listed in this item matches the serial number of the sensor for which you intend to complete section A of this form. If not, review the first occurrence of the EIO form to ensure that the sensor serial number is keyed to the correct participant ID and vice versa.
- 2. Record the date the ECG Patch sensor was returned to the clinic. If the device was returned to the clinic early, add a notelog explaining what happened.
- 3. Record the date that the ECG Patch sensor was sent to BioTel or iRhythm.
