



INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALDRETE SCORE FORM ALD, VERSION 2.0, QUESTION BY QUESTION (QxQ)

I. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

The Aldrete Score Form (ALD) is to be completed twice, both pre- and post-bronchoscopy, and will be used to determine the participant's Aldrete score. An Aldrete score of ≥ 9 is required for discharge.

Header Information: The header information consists of key fields which uniquely identify each recorded instance of a form. For the Event field, record if this is happening at Visit 5 or another event.

0a. Date of Collection: Record the date the data was collected or abstracted. Select the date from the pop-up calendar in the data management system (DMS) or type the date in the space provided. Dates should be entered in the mm/dd/yyyy format.

0b. Staff Code: Record the SPIROMICS staff code of the person who collected or abstracted the data. This code is assigned to each person at each site by the GIC. If you do not have a staff code and are collecting SPIROMICS data please contact the GIC in order to receive your own individual staff code.

II. DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS FOR EACH ITEM

Please answer every question on this form.

Item 0c. **Time of Collection:** Enter the time of collection.

Item 0d. **When was form collected:** Select only one option among the two possible choices.

- Select 'Pre-bronchoscopy procedure' if the form was collected pre-bronchoscopy procedure.
- Select 'Post-bronchoscopy procedure / Pre-discharge' if the form was collected post-bronchoscopy procedure / pre-discharge.

Item 1. **Current activity level:** Select only one option among the three possible choices.

- Select 'Moves all extremities voluntarily/on command' if the participant is able to move all extremities voluntarily and/or on command.
- Select 'Moves 2 extremities' if the participant can move at least 2 extremities.
- Select 'Cannot move extremities' if the participant cannot move at least 2 extremities.

Item 2. **Current respiration:** Select only one option among the three possible choices.

- Select 'Breathes deeply and coughs freely' if the participant is able to breathe deeply and cough freely.
- Select 'Is dyspneic, with shallow, limited breathing' if the participant is dyspneic with shallow, limited breathing.

- Select 'Is apneic' if the participant is apneic.

Item 3. **Blood Pressure:** Select only one option among the three possible choices.

- Select 'Is $\pm 20\%$ > pre-anesthetic level' if the participant's blood pressure is $\pm 20\%$ greater than preanesthetic level.
- Select 'Is $\pm 20-49\%$ > pre-anesthetic level' if the participant's blood pressure is $\pm 20-49\%$ greater than preanesthetic level.
- Select 'Is $\pm 50\%$ > pre-anesthetic level' if the participant's blood pressure is $\pm 50\%$ greater than preanesthetic level.

Item 4. **Current consciousness:** Select only one option among the three possible choices.

- Select 'Is fully awake' if the participant is fully awake.
- Select 'Is arousable on calling' if the participant is arousable upon calling.
- Select 'Is not responding' if the participant is not responding.

Item 5. **Oxygen saturation:** Select only one option among the three possible choices.

- Select 'Has SpO₂ level > 92% when breathing room air' if the participant has an SpO₂ level greater than 92% when breathing room air.
- Select 'Requires supplemental oxygen to maintain SpO₂ level > 90%' if the participant requires supplemental oxygen to maintain an SpO₂ level greater than 90%.
- Select 'Has SpO₂ level < 90% despite having oxygen supplementation' if the participant has an SpO₂ level less than 90% with oxygen supplementation.

Item 6. **TOTAL SCORE:** This field will be calculated in CDART and populated based on the answers entered to the items above.

An Aldrete score of ≥ 9 is required for discharge.
